What do we use your data for?

Automatically collected data is used to ensure the error-free and stable provision of the website. The data you enter is used to create and manage your user access account.

GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE LEGAL BASES FOR DATA PROCESSING ON THIS WEBSITE

3. DATA COLLECTION ON THIS WEBSITE

SERVER LOG FILES

The provider of the pages automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. These include:

- Browser type and browser version
- Operating system used
- Referrer URL, meaning the previously visited page
- Host name of the accessing computer
- Time of the server request
- IP address

This data is collected on the basis of Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR. The website operator has a legitimate interest in the technically error-free presentation, stability, and optimization of the website; for this purpose, server log files must be collected.

REGISTRATION ON THIS WEBSITE

You can register on this website in order to use additional features. The data entered during registration, such as name, email address, and password, is used only for the purpose of using the respective offer or service for which you have registered. The mandatory information requested during registration must be provided in full; otherwise, we will reject the registration.

The data entered during registration is processed for the purpose of fulfilling the user relationship established by the registration and, where applicable, initiating further contracts pursuant to Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR.

The data collected during registration is stored by us for as long as you remain registered on this website and is subsequently deleted when you delete your account. Statutory retention periods remain unaffected.

4. HOSTING

EXTERNAL HOSTING

This website is hosted by an external service provider, the hosting partner. The personal data collected on this website is stored on the hosting provider's servers. This primarily includes IP addresses, metadata and communication data, as well as registration data.

We operate the cloud server(s) under our own administrative responsibility. The server location is Nuremberg, Germany.

The hosting provider is used for the purpose of fulfilling our contractual obligations toward our users pursuant to Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR and in the interest of providing our online services securely, quickly, and efficiently pursuant to Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR.

To ensure data protection-compliant processing, we have concluded a data processing agreement with our hosting provider.

5. COOKIES

TECHNICALLY NECESSARY COOKIES

Our website uses only technically necessary cookies, such as session cookies for login recognition. These cookies are strictly necessary to ensure the smooth operation of the website and the protected member area. They are automatically deleted after the browser is closed or after logout. Storage is based on Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR, our legitimate interest in a functional web application.

6. PAYMENT PROCESSING VIA PAYPAL

USE OF PAYPAL

We use the payment service provider PayPal to process payments and manage subscriptions. If you choose to pay via PayPal or by using a credit card payment option offered by PayPal, the personal data required for payment processing will be transmitted to PayPal.

This may include, in particular, the following data:

- Name
- Email address
- Payment and transaction data
- Invoice amount and currency
- Other information required to carry out the payment

PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF PROCESSING

Data is transmitted exclusively for the purpose of carrying out the payment process, managing your subscription, and handling refunds and other payment-related transactions. The legal basis for this processing is Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR (performance of a contract or implementation of pre-contractual measures).

SUBSCRIPTION MANAGEMENT VIA WEBHOOKS

To manage your subscription, PayPal transmits information to us about the status of your payment and subscription via so-called webhooks. This may include, in particular, notifications of successful payments, renewals, cancellations, suspensions, or refunds. This information is processed exclusively to correctly manage your user account, subscription status, and the contractually agreed services, as well as to comply with statutory documentation and verification obligations.

RESPONSIBILITY OF PAYPAL
